Economy, Management, Mathematics, Physics and Information Technology

Doctoral School n°405 – Economy, Management, Mathematics, Physics and Information Technology (EM2PSI), hosted by CY Cergy Paris Université has several doctoral contract positions, providing 3 years of funded research, available for academic year 2024-2025. Applications, selection and interviews will be carried out until the summer, with a start of the contract on the 1st of October of 2024. These doctoral contract positions are available to candidates who wish to prepare a PhD in one of the research units of CY Cergy Paris Université attached to our doctoral school.

Doctoral supervision

To apply, a candidate must first find a potential supervisor. This person should be a member of one of the research units of CY Cergy Paris Université attached to our doctoral school.

- Only certain members of the research units are *habilitated* to supervise doctoral students. These include full professors, research directors (« directeurs or directrices de recherche of the CNRS »), junior researchers that have a supervision habilitation (« habilitation à diriger des recherches » or HDR) as well as some special cases. Please note that some supervisors may have reached their maximum allowed number of supervised doctoral students.
- The CY Cergy Paris Université research units attached to this doctoral school are AGM (mathematics), LPTM (theoretical physics), ThEMA (Economics and Management) et ETIS (Communication and Information Technologies)
- **Specifically for a PhD in the ETIS research unit**, candidates must apply specifically to one of the research topics being advertised by the research unit. Each topic proposal lists the thesis supervisor that would be in charge of that specific topic.

The list of the members of each research unit is available on that unit's website (see below). **Additionally, candidates must contact the Director of the research unit where they wish to carry out their thesis and send him/her their application file, respecting any deadlines set by the research unit.**

Expected documents for an application for a doctoral contract

The required documents are :

1. A Cover Letter explaining your motivations for doing a PhD and why you'd like to do one here
2. A detailed CV
3. An official document with your grades from your Masters/MSc
4. A detailed description of your doctoral proposal
5. Recommendations letters, including one from the proposed doctoral supervisor
6. If you have not yet obtained your Masters/MSc degree, a signed letter by your

Masters/MSc internship supervisor indicating when your Masters/MSc thesis will be (or has been) defended.

The completed (uncomplete applications will be discarded) application, with all required documents, must be sent to the EM2PSI Doctoral School **at latest on the 17th th of June 2024** to the aforementioned contact email: edem2psi@ml.u-cergy.fr. You are kindly asked to prefer sending the required documents as PDFs.

Funding allocation announcement

The decision concerning which doctoral projects and candidates will receive the doctoral contract funding will be made public **on the 01st of July 2024**.

Please note that :

- Monthly untaxed income of doctoral research benefiting from a doctoral contract is **2100 euros, but this will increase in the upcoming years**
- It is, by law, but it isn't automatic, possible for doctoral contract researchers to be given supplementary missions (most often, teaching duties, between 0 and 64 hours per academic year). This possibility is examined during the PhD, once the contract is obtained.
- A Co-supervisors and well as junior supervisors (which don't require the HDR) may be associated to the doctoral project.
