These positions are intended for students aiming to pursue a doctorate within one of the affiliated research laboratories.

Finding a Supervisor

Applicants must identify a thesis supervisor prior to submitting their application. The supervisor must be affiliated with one of the school's research laboratories. Eligible supervisors include professors, research directors, HDR holders, and others in specific cases. Affiliated labs include AGM (Mathematics), LPTM (Theoretical Physics), ThEMA (Economics & Management), and ETIS (Information & Communication Technologies). ETIS candidates must apply directly to specific listed projects, which specify the supervising faculty. The application site for ETIS is <https://www.adum.fr/candidature/>.  Contact the relevant laboratory and submit your application following its internal process and deadlines. Use the appropriate email or submission portal provided by the laboratory.

Application Components

The application must include :

- A cover letter
- A detailed CV
- Master's degree transcripts
- A thesis proposal
- Letters of recommendation, including one from the proposed supervisor
- If the Master's degree is pending: a letter from the Master's thesis supervisor confirming the thesis has been or will be defended, with the planned date.

Final decisions will be announced **by July 15, 2025**.

Gross monthly salary : approximately €2,200

An additional assignment (e.g., up to 64 hours of teaching annually) may be added to the contract
Co-supervisors and co-advisors (not necessarily HDR holders) may also assist in thesis supervision
