## Finding a Supervisor

Applicants must identify a thesis supervisor prior to submitting their application. The supervisor must be affiliated with one of the school's research laboratories. Eligible supervisors include professors, research directors, HDR holders, and others in specific cases. Affiliated labs include AGM (Mathematics), LPTM (Theoretical Physics), ThEMA (Economics & Management), and ETIS (Information & Communication Technologies). ETIS candidates must apply directly to specific listed projects, which specify the supervising faculty. - If the Master's degree is pending: a letter from the Master's thesis
